

Religious Policy

Sagan Centre is not affiliated to any one religion. At the core of our philosophy is respect for all faiths, which is built through an understanding of the diverse religious beliefs of the children who attend our school. Incorporated in the Sagan Centre ethos is the teaching of the values of tolerance and understanding. Humanism and values education is taught as part of our formal curriculum as well as in the informal and hidden curriculum.

In keeping with this philosophy Sagan Centre fully respects the right of individuals to observe religious holy days. Sagan Centre will try to avoid clashes with major religious festivals where this is practical. The decision to miss school activities is a personal one and, while every effort will be made to assist the student in making up work missed, the observation of the religious holy days may, in no way, impact upon the operational needs of the school.

Although we are a multi-faith school, it must be understood that the Sagan Centre uniform will not be modified to suit any specific religious practice. The wearing of any religious headdress will be at the discretion of the school.
