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EXAM PREPARATION - IGCSE and AS/A Level

Cambridge External exams and Sagan Internal exams

- **PLANNING** is the key to success
- DAILY ROUTINES and practice are essential
- EXTENDED READING AND RESEARCH to develop a sound personal response to content is essential for critical thinking

The following are prerequisites for good results at IGCSE and AS/A level:

Lesson preparation

- 1) Study methods and techniques should be tried and tested in the IGCSE year. Adapt, rethink it, redo it.
- 2) **Mind maps** must consistently be drawn up per chapter/topic being studied. Connections must be made to the preceding and/or proceeding chapters mind maps should then be reformulated with parts to the whole.
- 3) **Pre-reading BEFORE** every subject lesson is essential to success.
- 4) Mind maps are essential once a chapter/topic is completed.
- 5) **EXTENDED reading and research** is compulsory at AS/A Level

Exam preparation

- 1) At least 15 (FIFTREEN) past papers MUST be completed per component (not per subject).
- 2) If a subject has three components (i.e. Paper 1 Multiple Choice, Paper 2 Theory and Paper 3 Alternative to practical, then that is 15x3 past papers per component making it a **total of 45 past paper for that subject**.
- 3) Cambridge Memorandums MUST be used in conjunctions with past papers to determine and understand HOW Cambridge International award marks
- 4) All sections and topics MUST be studied equally, unless advised by a teacher.
- 5) Big picture thinking, with refined specific detailed responses must be practiced
- 6) All subject specific terminology and definitions must be learnt (no vague terminology will be accepted by Cambridge)

Cambridge Past Papers and memorandums – IGCSE and AS/A Level

***All IGCSE AND AS/A Level students are required to have an arch lever file PER SUBJECT with at least 20 to 40 past papers PER COMPONENT (per paper). These past paper files must be readied by no later than 28 Februaryof any given year.
